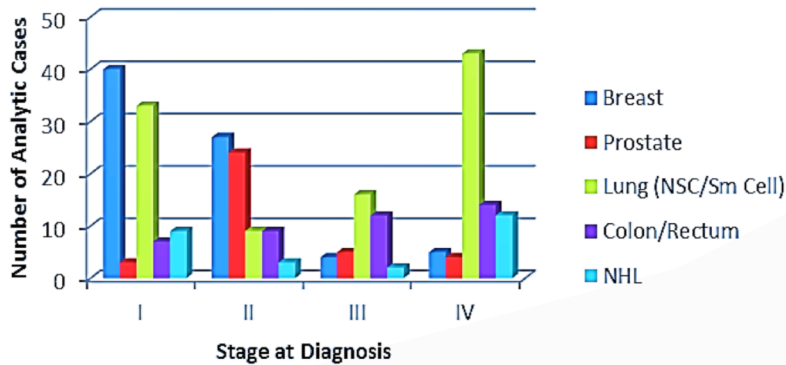

- Total Cases expected in Yuba/Sutter Counties per American Cancer Society “Cancer Facts & Figures 2014” in 2014 was 655. Rideout Health (RH) actual number of analytic cases in 2014 were 523(total cases 606), less than Yuba and Sutter counties expected.
- **Breast Cancer rates:** 90% of all breast cancers diagnosed at RH in 2014 are stage 0, I or II, (60% are diagnosed with stage 0 or I). RH 2012 incidence rates are similar to NCDB 2012 invasive breast cancer incidence rate for comprehensive hospitals throughout the nation. RH incidence rates for invasive female only breast cancer is higher than the Nation and Yuba/Sutter Counties expected.
- **Prostate Cancer rates:** Seventy-one percent of all RH analytic prostate cases are diagnosed at either stage I or II. Prostate incidence rates at RH are less than the expected rates for the Nation, State of California and Yuba/Sutter counties and NCDB 2012 data.
- **Lung Cancer rates:** RH’s lung cancers diagnosed at stage III or IV has remained the majority of cases. In 2014, 58% of the lung cancers were diagnosed at stage III or IV (43% were stage IV). NCDB 2012 Comprehensive hospitals reported 14% of all cases as lung cancer, higher than RH 2012 reported cases. Rideout Health’s lung cancer cases for 2014 are higher than the counties, state and nation expected. Yuba/Sutter counties have an “expected” lung cancer rate of 14% each per ACS. The rate of 20% in 2014 at RH, represents a migration into the RH system with a quarter of those patients living outside of the community.
- **Colo/Rectal Cancer rates:** RH has a slightly higher incidence of colon cancer than Nation, State and Counties expected. Fifty seven percent of the colo/rectal cancers at RH are diagnosed at stage III or IV.
- **NHL:** Incident rates have stayed relatively stable over the years at RH, and are similar to the expected rates of the State. Nation. Counties and NCDB data.
