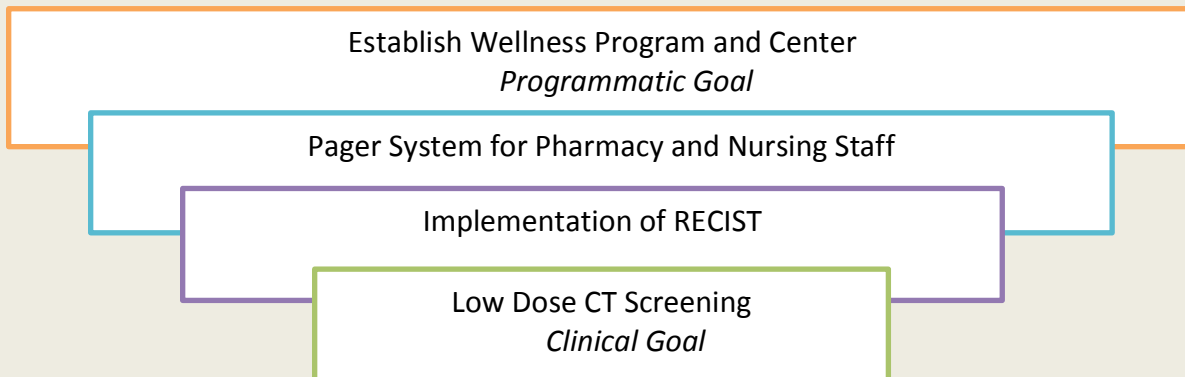

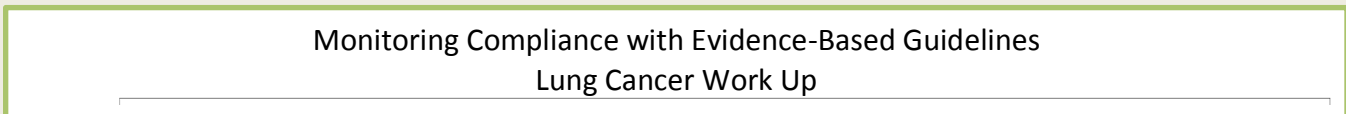

Study Topic & Criteria	Analysis & Outcome
<p>Topic: Assess Nationally recognized treatment guidelines are used in the formulation of the first course of treatment.</p> <p>Criteria: Reviewed 2013 Rideout Health's newly diagnosed stage Ia Lung cancer patients.</p>	<p>Analysis: RH had 74 analytic non-small cell lung cancer cases in 2013. Thirteen of those were diagnosed at presentation with a stage Ia. According to the NCCN guidelines, Stage Ia non-small cell lung cancer cases are to be worked up according to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1)Scan-PET/CT</li> <li>2)Bronchoscopy</li> <li>3)Pathological mediastinal LN evaluation</li> </ul> <p>Initial treatment for stage Ia non-small cell lung cancer is surgery (for operable patients), or RT for medically inoperable patients.</p> <p>Outcome: 13 patients diagnosed in 2013 at RH with stage Ia non-small lung cancer. All 13 patients had a PET/CT. 11/13 patients had a bronchoscopy and 5/13 had pathological mediastinal LN evaluation. Nine patients were surgical candidates and had surgery, 3 patients were not surgical candidates and had XRT, and one patient did not return for any additional treatment.</p>
